CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

APPROVE MEETING MINUTES:

Supervisor Brent Patten motioned to approve the April 2011 Meeting Minutes; Regis Thoma seconded. Approved by all.

APPROVE TREASURER'S REPORT:

Supervisor Regis Thoma motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report for the month of April; Brent Patten seconded. Approved by all.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

<u>Terry Wingfield – Variance Request</u> – Mr. Wingfield was present and asked if there was a way to work around the Township's set-back ordinance.

<u>Frank Marzullo – Sign Ordinance</u> – Mr. Marzullo offered his services to the Board of Supervisors and advised that he has worked with other municipalities in preparing their sign ordinance. He can be reached at Signtronix.com (724) 968-2630.

<u>Jim Moser – Road Crew Starting Time</u> – Mr. Moser asked the Road Crew what time they start. Lonny stated that 5:30 a.m. is the start time.

<u>Jim Moser – Township Truck Use</u> – Mr. Moser expressed his opinion regarding the practice of the Roadmaster taking the Township truck home. The Board agreed to leave things the way that they are now.

CORRESPONDENCE:

East Butler Baseball Association – Brian Hans motioned to give the donation of \$300 to the baseball association; Regis Thoma seconded. Approved by all.

ARLE Grant – Nadine Neff received word that our grant request in the amount of \$21,000 has been granted to replace the school lights outside of Oakland Township Elementary. The boad discussed and agreed that a switch should be added for the school principal to trigger the lights.

STAFF REPORTS:

Lonny Jewart – Rain has delayed the sweeping process.

PENROD – It has been agreed that the property owner will make the pipe visible on both ends and that the Township will flush out. Lonny asked that the Board make a policy that we stick to. The Board advised that with our new ordinance it is the responsibility of the homeowner to maintain and clear his culvert pipes.

FOX WATER – The Board okayed Lonny checking with Mr. Fox regarding the filling of the Twp water truck at his pump.

David Meeder – Dave discussed with the Board an issue regarding Kimberly Matson on Lake Road paving her driveway without a permit and that the newly blacktopped driveway extends more than 2 feet onto Lake Road. Brian Hans advised that the driveway needs to be removed from our road.

Further discussion ensued regarding the charges for permits if the resident is doing basic upgrading. The Board agreed that only major changes would be charged and that fees for culvert replacements, etc. would be waived.
